Re: In-Suite Maintenance Requests & Work Orders

As you may be aware, on March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization (WHO) classified the COVID-19 virus (Novel Coronavirus) as a pandemic.

The health and safety of our residents and team members is very important to Metcap. Under the direction of the Public Health Agency of Canada (PHAC), and our other government health agencies, we all must work together to reduce the risk of transmission of the COVID-19 virus in Canada.

- Non-working appliances
- Fire and safety items

Elective or cosmetic items, such as painting, plastering and sanding & refinishing floors will be completed at a later date.

Please also be advised that, until further notice, the laundry room(s) will be available for use 24 hours per day, 7 days per week. This will assist our residents in maintaining a safe social distance during this period of uncertainty.
